Women' Ministries Initiative Rules

- 1. Membership is achieved by subscribing to the Initiative, costing the subscriber 2 British pounds per month. Subscription however heeds to be paid either in full annually either by cash or cheque or by setting up a quarterly Standing Order. The new subscription year 2015 will commence on the 1st of January 2015.
- 2. All current subscribers will receive information about Women' Ministries Initiative events and will be able to have either discounted or free participation in the events of the Initiative.
