The Call to Revive the Female Diaconate: *Thirty Years After Rhodes*

Hosted by the St. Phoebe Center for the Deaconess and the <u>Saint Catherine Institute</u> for Orthodox Christian Studies

In 1988, the Ecumenical Patriarch Dimitrios I convened an international Orthodox consultation to discuss the "Place of Women in the Orthodox Church and the Question of the Ordination of Women."

Official representatives from the various Orthodox churches met in Rhodes, Greece and, among other things, concluded that the female diaconate should be revived.

In recognition of the 30th anniversary of the consultation, the Chicago event will discuss the developments that have come about since the call for the revival of the female diaconate and the issues that still surround this question.

OCN Interviews Board Member Carrie Frederick Frost on Motherhood

Orthodox Christian Network (OCN) founding father and OCN host Fr. Chris Metropulos recently interviewed St. Phoebe Center board member Carrie Frederick Frost, Ph.D., on the topic of motherhood, the Church, and Orthodox theology.

In her interview, Carrie spoke about the importance of mothers in the church today contributing their thoughts and experiences of motherhood to the Church, as well as theological anthropology (what it means to be a human person), the consecration of the deaconesses in Africa, and the need for the ministry of female deacons today.

Carrie is also a Professor at Saint Sophia Ukrainian Orthodox Seminary. Her book, *Maternal Body: A Theology of the Body from the Christian East*, will be published by Paulist Press in 2019.
